POLICY: Antiseizure Medications – Zonisamide Step Therapy Policy

- Zonegran® (zonisamide capsules Concordia, generic)
- Zonisade[™] (zonisamide oral suspension Azurity)

OVERVIEW

All of these products are indicated as adjunctive therapy for the treatment of partial-onset seizures in adults and pediatric patients \geq 16 years of age with epilepsy.^{1,2}

Zonisamide capsules are available in 25 and 100 mg strengths and should be swallowed whole.¹ Zonisade is available as a 100 mg/5 mL strawberry flavored oral suspension.²

POLICY STATEMENT

This program has been developed to encourage the use of a Step 1 Product prior to the use of a Step 2 Product. If the Step Therapy rule is not met for a Step 2 Product at the point of service, coverage will be determined by the Step Therapy criteria below. All approvals are provided for 1 year in duration.

<u>Automation</u>: A patient with a of one Step 1 Product within the 130-day look-back period is excluded from Step Therapy.

Step 1: generic zonisamide capsules

Step 2: Zonisade, Zonegran (brand)

CRITERIA

- 1. If the patient has tried one Step 1 Product, approve a Step 2 Product.
- 2. If the patient cannot swallow or has difficulty swallowing solid oral dosage forms, approve Zonisade.
- **3.** No other exceptions are recommended.
